On December 9, 1996, Brymar Communications Corporation (Brymar), filed an application with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for a certificate of authority to operate as a telecommunications company within the state of South Dakota.

Brymar has requested tha application be withdrawn without formal action of the Commission either granting or denying it.

A regularly scheduled June 3, 1997, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD Chapter 20:10:24. The Commission found that Brymar's request to withdraw its application for a certificate of authority is reasonable and closed the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED that this docket is closed.
