On July 2, 2001, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation (Qwest) for approval of revisions to its Exchange and Network Services Tariff. The revisions increase the Federal Telephone Assistance Plan credit from \$6.10 to \$6.75 to offset the \$.65 increase in the Residence Subscriber Line Charge.

On July 5, 2001, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 20, 2001, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.
