On June 27, 2005, City of Brookings Municipal Telephone Department (Brookings) filed for approval by the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) its 2004 Intrastate Switched Access Cost Study. On August 17, 2005, Brookings filed an amended 2004 Intrastate Switched Access Cost Study.

On June 30, 2005, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 15, 2005, to interested individuals and entities. On September 1, 2005, the Commission received Petitions to Intervene from MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC (MCI) and Midcontinent Communications (Midcontinent). On September 14, 2005, the Commission received a Petition to Intervene from AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T). On September 16, 2005, the Commission received a Joint Answer of LECs to MCI and Midcontinent's Petitions to Intervene. On September 23, 2005, the Commission received a Joint Answer of LECs to AT&T's Petitions to Intervene. On September 26, 2005, the Commission received Staff's Response to MCI, Midcontinent and AT&T's Petitions to Intervene.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 1-26-17.1, 49-1A-9, 49-31-12.6, 49-31-18, 49-31-19 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.02, 20:10:01:15.05, 20:10:27:07 and 20:10:27:08.

At a regularly scheduled meeting of September 27, 2005, the Commission found that the Petitions to Intervene demonstrated good cause to grant intervention. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Petitions to Intervene of MCI, Midcontinent and AT&T are hereby granted.
