On November 12, 2008, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from OrbitCom, Inc. (OrbitCom) for approval of revisions to its Switched Access Services Tariff. OrbitCom seeks to change its current switched access rates, which mirror Qwest rates, to the rates charged by other similarly situated competitive local exchange carriers. On November 13, 2008, the Commission received a Supplemental Petition from OrbitCom. On November 13, 2008, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of November 28, 2008, to interested individuals and entities. On November 21, 2008, AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed to intervene. On December 9, 2008, the Commission granted intervention to AT&T.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.05

At its regularly scheduled meeting of July 12, 2011, Commission Staff stated that OrbitCom had agreed to the dismissal and closing of this docket due to its filing of TC11-074. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the docket shall be dismissed and closed.
