On May 29, 2014, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Knology of the Black Hills, LLC (Knology) requesting approval of revisions to its Access Tariff No. 1. The purpose of this filing is to revise its terminating rates to maintain compliance with the FCC's order in FCC 11-161. Knology requests an effective date of July 1, 2014. On June 5, 2014, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 20, 2014, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention. On June 13 and July 15, 2014, Knology responded to Staff's data requests. On July 24, 2014, Knology filed revised tariff pages.

The following Tariff No. 1 pages were filed for Commission approval:

At its regularly scheduled meeting on August 19, 2014, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. Commission Staff recommended approval. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the revisions to Knology's Tariff No. 1. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the above-referenced pages of Knology's Tariff No. 1 with an effective date of July 1, 2014.
