On May 22, 2015, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) requesting approval of revisions to its South Dakota Access Service Tariff. This filing is the fourth step in implementing the Transitional Intrastate Access Service reductions mandated by the Federal Communications Commission's November 18, 2011, Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, et al. (FCC 11-161). A July 1, 2015, effective date is requested.

On May 28, 2015, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 12, 2015, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the above-referenced revisions to CenturyLink's Access Service Tariff with an effective date of July 1, 2015.
